The elephant health care center is centrally located among the three habitats at the Sanctuary. It houses the Sanctuary's advanced veterinary diagnostic and treatment equipment including Fauna Research's specially designed equipment for safe and protected care of elephants.

The Sanctuary has made a commitment to care for these elephants for the entirety of their lifespan. With this specialized equipment, that serves as a walk-in elephant health clinic, they are prepared for all of their health and husbandry needs as the residents age.

Since 1995, The Elephant Sanctuary in Tennessee has provided elephants retired from performance and exhibition with a safe refuge and the companionship of other elephants. The facility has grown from 110 acres to 3,060 acres and has provided sanctuary to 28 elephants, making it North America's largest natural habitat refuge for captive elephants.
